Directions to show grounds

From I-5 North/South: Take the Woodburn Exit 271, go east through town on Highway 214, turns into Highway 211. Follow for 12 miles to the center of Molalla (flashing red 4-way light). Turn LEFT at Molalla Avenue; continue straight though 1 stop sign. Turn RIGHT at the 3rd block onto Frances Street. E. Clark Park should be directly in front of you. Show is at the north end of the park.

From I-205 North/South: Take the Molalla Park Place Exit 10. Follow Highway 213 south for 15 miles to the intersection of Highway 211 (Safeway will be on LEFT) Turn LEFT and follow to 4 way flashing red light. Turn LEFT at Molalla Avenue; continue straight through 1 stop sign. Turn RIGHT at the 3rd block onto Frances Street. E. Clark Park should be directly in front of you. Show is at the north end of the park.

Show grounds open July 9th, 2020 after 5:00 PM, depart show grounds July 12th, 2020 before 5:00 PM
